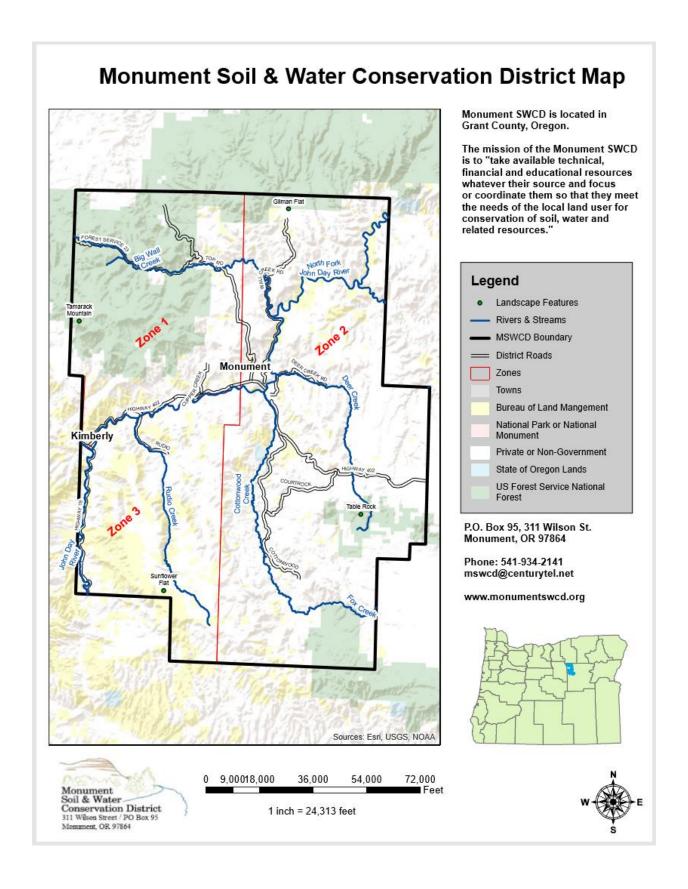

Accomplishments for Fiscal Year 2018 – 2019

Changes to the Board of Directors:

• Jeff Thomas was appointed as the At-Large 1 Director on December 3, 2018 to replace Tammy Fields who resigned from that position on September 27, 2018.

Changes to the Staff:

- Lauren Street was hired as the new Project Manager on February 19, 2019.
- Greg Hill was hired as the new District Manager on June 3, 2019.
- As of this report date, the Monument SWCD has restructured office staffing and added a new management position. on January 2, 2019, Ally Steinmetz was hired as new Assistant Project Manager and Lauren Street assumed the role of Senior Project Manager. On January 13, 2019, a special meeting was held and the Monument SWCD staff and Board of Directors agreed that BA Robbins would assume the role of District Manager with Greg Hill moving into the role of Assistant District Manager.
